
ACTIVITIES

Musical experiences are promoted through listening, singing, and playing rhythm instruments.

Creative art is encouraged through various media such as tempera paint, finger paint, play doh, crayons, scissors, and paste.

An active play period, both indoor and outdoor emphasizes large and small muscle development.

Creative play is encouraged in play centers, such as housekeeping, puppet stage, and blocks.

Literature includes listening to stories, learning finger plays, and developing an appreciation for books.

Field trips, scheduled throughout the year, are an important part of the pre-school program.

Science is included as children learn about changes in seasons, growing plants, and exploring the natural world.

Math skills can be developed through counting objects, counting days of the week on the calendar, and participating in counting games.

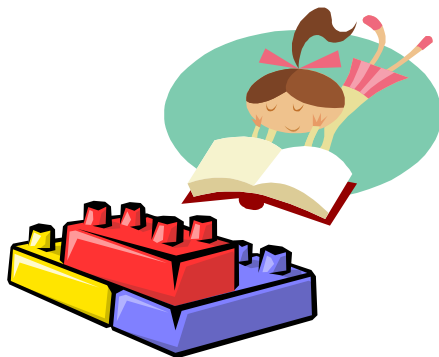

The Preschool Program

The program at Saint Paul Preschool includes a flexible and informal schedule that is geared to the younger child. Children are given an opportunity to develop self confidence and social skills as they are exposed to a variety of readiness activities.



In our preschool, we hope to provide the atmosphere and environment that will stimulate and promote the total growth and well-being of each child. We hope to provide unhurried time for each child to be three and to be four—a place where the child can say, “It is good to be here; it is good to be me!”



ADMISSION POLICY

Enrollment to the preschool is open to children of all faiths and ethnic backgrounds. Applications for enrollment will be accepted for the following school year on the first preschool day after January 1, and continue until classes are filled.



A completed application form, accompanied by a non-refundable application fee of \$45.00 is required for admission.

All children entering the preschool program must be one or two years away from entering kindergarten, and should be three or four years of age on or before September 30.
